Why buy 4-H/FFA raised animals?

- The animals are hand raised by 4-H/FFA Youth.
- It's cheaper to buy the animal on the hoof. A steer yields approximately 60% of its weight in retail meat cuts; a sheep 50%; and a hog 70%.
- The average price per pound at the 4-H/FFA Livestock Sale is about the same as you would pay for an inexpensive cut of meat at the market.
- You can have the meat cut and wrapped to your specifications (billed separately by processor).
- Purchasing an animal through the 4-H/FFA Livestock Sale is a way to support and show pride in your community.
- You are supporting positive local youth programs.
 4-H/FFA teaches our youth responsibility, how to keep records, and how to manage money.
- As a livestock buyer, you receive publicity for yourself and/or your business.
